Dear friends,

Positioned directly in front of the fan in our over-heated flat, I am writing to you in order to give you a brief update from the Njock family in France.

The summer holiday period has begun, which means that most activities are wound down. Less people in the Sunday services, church activities down to the minimum, and also our regular activities at the YWAM centre have been put on pause. However, the centre will receive a number of visitors who want to use the facilities for a break, a holiday or a spiritual retreat. So, we since we are not planning to go away this summer, we will be looking after the centre. As I write to you, there is a Summer of Service taking place in Paris, called „Paris, je t'aime“ (Paris, I love you). Organised by YWAM France, this event has been taking place for the last 7 years. Approximately 100 participants are evangelizing in the streets and squares of the Capital, even in the Metro and wherever it is possible.

We are supporting this event from here in prayer, while our two oldest boys are making the most of their summer holidays in their respective summer camps.

Nathanael has remained with us – and is getting a bit bored without his brothers – but at the end of next week everyone will be reunited.

The preparations for September are our main occupation right now. Samuel is also helping with the dispatch of French version of the prayer booklet “30 Days of Prayer for the Muslim World“, that is edited by one of our team members. This booklet is a prayer guide during the month of Ramadan (this year starting in August) – a very precious tool. Apart from that, we are looking after the base and try to do all the things we don't get around to do otherwise.

The next „Event“ will be our national YWAM staff conference at the base near Paris (Gault la Forêt) at the end of August. All the “YWAMers” of France get together for a time of reorientation, mutual encouragement, and edification (Tom Bloomer will be teaching us). We are looking forward to meeting our “colleagues” and be strengthened in our ministry for the year ahead of us.
